Janbeck*'s FAIRhaus was founded in 2006 as a small eco guesthouse on a derelict farm near the Baltic Sea, near Denmark. The sustainable family business has grown bit by bit and is now a climate positive hotel with 21 beds in 7 different quarters. Biodiversity, short distances, waste avoidance and recycling are most important.

The aim is to create as many cycles as possible: from treated water to the products on the breakfast table. Self-generated electricity is fed into electric cars, employees are trained themselves and employed throughout the year.
